BRING WHATEVER WATERCOLOR SUPPLIES YOU NORMALLY USE. If you need guidance in selection, here are suggestions. Select one color from each group below. My preferred choice is listed first. To save money, eliminate the optional colors.

TUBE PAINTS: Daniel Smith-DS Da Vinci-DV Winsor & Newton-WN Maimeri Blu-MB

BRUSHES: 1" Watercolor Flat 1/2" Watercolor Flat Round brush that comes to a good point.
I prefer the squirrel hair and synthetic blend, produced by Daniel Smith, Langnickel, Black Velvet, etc.

PAPER: 100% Rag Paper is a must. Winsor & Newton 140 lb Cold Press is preferred, or Arches 140 lb or 300 lb is okay. You may use either individual half sheets, quarter sheets or a watercolor block. The watercolor block requires no clips or painting board. The individual sheets can be either clipped or stapled to the painting board. Advanced painters may work on full sheets.

DRAWING: #2 School Pencil
Black Brush Pen--felt marker type, Tombow (N15 or N25) or Mars. These are water-soluble markers. (Available from Daniel Smith, below) Black watercolor and a small brush would also work for ink drawings.
Bristol Drawing Pad--11x14" or similar size—plate or smooth preferred. Or Rising Drawing Bristol is available in 22"x30" sheets from Daniel Smith, excellent quality. I cut the large sheet into fourths (11x15).
Reference Photos--for practice, any subject. Painting demonstrations include: landscape, floral, people, or animals.
Mat with about an 8"x10" opening (may be cardboard or paper)

OTHER: Small tube of Black Acrylic paint—optional
3 or 4 Q-tips (cotton swabs)—optional
Painting Board and Clips—Choices include Plywood or Gatorboard (available Cheap Joe & Jerry's), size 16x23", plus Bull Dog clips, staples, or watercolor wash out tape, for attaching paper to board. Plywood boards work best if they are sealed with one coat of acrylic medium or household spray varnish, etc.
Watercolor Palette
Shallow Water Container—for cleaning brushes
Natural Sponge—for wetting paper and lifting paint
Old Tooth Brush—for lifting paint
Paper Towels or Kleenex
Old Bath Towel
